GWTW-TV STUDIO & CLASSROOM

GWTW is taking steps to open a public space in the town of Grapevine, TX, a tourist center of 47,000 residents situated on the northwest side of Dallas/Fort Worth Int'l Airport and about half way between Dallas and Fort Worth.



The GWTW multipurpose space of, perhaps 1500 sq. ft., is being designed to house all aspects of the ministry, especially the STUDIO that will accommodate 24/7 streaming. In addition, it will house GWTW College, The Int'l Christian Women's Hall of Fame, GWTW Library and Resources, and Offices for daily operations. It will provide space for volunteers to help carry daily responsibilities.

The STUDIO is a high priority at this stage of development. It will increase the quality of our live streaming, established in our home in 2006 and now streamed from our Grapevine apartment.

It appears that the ministry will be able to acquire the basic studio equipment by the end of June, 2013. This will enable us to record and/or stream programming that would be available to any/all cable/satellite outlets. It will enable us to broadcast 24/7 on the Internet, including GWTW COLLEGE. It will enable any and all phones, tablets and computers to access the Stream/TV and will create apps for these devises so that one click will assure instant access.

DESIGN: The décor of the entire space will be the *Int'l Christian Women's Hall of Fame* displays and materials. And it will mean that Hall of Fame inductions can resume. The floorplan will include classroom seating for local students of *God's Word to Women College*.

IMMEDIATELY upon purchase of the Studio Equipment, we can begin production of a weekly, 30-minute program with our home serving as a studio until public space is acquired. The 30-minute program would be carried on a website dedicated solely to GWTW TV, the GWTW You-Tube Channel, and local free or low-cost, community, educational channels on local cable TV networks.

- The 30-minute program mentioned above
- Programs by friends who share the vision and purpose
- Call-in programs using Internet Chat Room, Skype, & Phones.
- Book readings
- Prayer Times
- Special programming in other languages
